The Lehman Cave Excursion was very enjoyable. In attendance were Sandy and Dave Maxwell, and Ann and Doug Lewis. You others. . . well, you missed a fun trip. The days couldn't have been better. We had a good drive, surprisingly good food and a nice tour through the cave. It is the most spectacular cave I have ever been in. We had refreshing Margaritas in the Bar/Restaurant in Baker, Nevada; the Maxwell's won money and the Lewis's lost money in the casino at the Border Inn; and the only rain we had was during the nighttime hours.

On the drive west of Delta, Utah, we observed some interesting looking "items" scattered around the desert. It turns out they are "Cosmic Ray" Catchers. This, of course, piqued our curiosity and with a little research this is what we found out:

The University of Utah and a group of Japanese and U.S. universities are spending millions (\$) to determine the mysterious source of the most energetic particles in the universe. They hope to find the answers in Utah's western desert. What is producing these subatomic particles? Whatever it is, it is the most energetic mechanism we know of in the universe short of the "big bang."

The physicists are using The Telescope Array which includes two types of devices scattered over a large area west and southwest of Delta, Utah. One type: three fluorescence detectors (sets of mirrors that detect faint blue flashes in the night sky when cosmic rays hit atmospheric gas molecules) are built on three hills.

Second type: A ground array of 576 scintillation detectors installed in a grid (18-by-22-mile area) west of Delta. When a cosmic ray hits atmospheric gases, it causes an "air shower" of other subatomic particles that reach the ground and will be measured by the detectors.

In studying these ultra-high-energy cosmic rays, physicists are hoping to learn more about the origin and structure of our universe. And I thought cosmic rays were just "sunshine."

Resolution Designating July 8, 2011, as “Collector Car Appreciation Day” Approved by U.S. Senate

At the request of the SAN, Senator John Tester (D-MT) and Senator Richard Burr (R-NC) have introduced and the Senate has approved Resolution 154 (S. Res. 154) in the United States Senate, officially designating July 8, 2011 as “Collector Car Appreciation Day.” S. Res. 154 states that the Senate “recognizes that the collection and restoration of historic and classic cars is an important part of preserving the technological achievements and cultural heritage of the United States.”



The date marks the second commemoration in what will become an annual event to raise awareness of the vital role automotive restoration and collection plays in American society. “Last year, thousands of Americans gathered at car cruises, parades and other events to celebrate our nation’s automotive heritage,” said SEMA Vice President of Government Affairs Steve McDonald. “As we move forward, SEMA’s commitment to preserving and promoting the automotive restoration industry through its projects and programs is evident in this special day.”

Senators Tester and Burr, both members of the Congressional Automotive Performance and Motorsports Caucus, have been strong advocates for the automotive hobby in Washington. By sponsoring S. Res. 154, Tester and Burr have reaffirmed their understanding of the cultural importance of collector cars. The caucus is an informal, non-partisan group that pays tribute to America’s ever growing love affair with the car and motorsports. The caucus recognizes the integral role collector cars have played in fostering our nation’s appreciation for the automobile’s unique historical place in our history.
